



EMS Broadcast Meteorologist Award 2007

The EMS announces the **European Meteorological Society Broadcast Meteorologist Award** to honour life achievement of an outstanding broadcast meteorologist. This award includes the reimbursement of travel and local costs of the awardee to the EMS Annual Meeting and European Conference on Applications of Meteorology 2007.

Who is eligible to receive the Broadcast Meteorologist Award and what are the requirements?

The candidate must be a European broadcast meteorologist with a long professional career in broadcast meteorology.

Who can propose a candidate for the EMS Broadcast Meteorologist Award?

A candidate is welcome to propose herself/himself.

Alternatively broadcast meteorologists may be proposed for the award by the following bodies:

- (i) any EMS Member Society or Associate Member,
- (ii) the EMS Media Committee or its individual members,
- (iii) professional associations of media meteorologists.

Each of the aforementioned bodies may nominate up to two candidates.

What documentation is requested?

In order to qualify for the EMS Broadcast Meteorologist Award the following documents are required:

- (i) a short professional curriculum vitae
- (ii) a supporting statement (e.g. by an EMS Member Society or an EMS Associate Member, or any of the proposing bodies mentioned above)

Where should the proposals be submitted?

How will the Award be presented?

The Award will be presented during the Media Session of the seventh EMS Annual Meeting and eighth European Conference on Applications of Meteorology 2007 in San Lorenzo de El Escorial. The awardee will be a special guest at the Media Session of this conference.
