



Young Scientist Award – 1000 €

In order to support excellence among young European scientists, EMS honours one promising young scientist with the **European Meteorological Society Young Scientist Award**. This award includes a sum of 1000 € and the reimbursement of travel and local costs of the awardee to the EMS Annual Meeting and European Conference on Applications of Meteorology.

Who is eligible to receive a Young Scientist Award?

Young scientists from countries which are EMS Members are eligible for an award. For a country overview please consult the EMS Web Site at www.emetsoc.org. Recipients shall be under 32 years of age on the first of January 2007.

What are the requirements?

The candidate must have written a high quality publication in a reviewed international scientific journal, or an outstanding PhD thesis. The paper shall have been published during the three years that precede the nomination.

What documentation is requested?

In order to qualify for a Young Scientist Award the following documents are required: (i) a short curriculum vitae, (ii) a document to determine the age of the candidate, (iii) a supporting statement (e.g. by an EMS Member Society or an EMS Associate Member) and (iv) three copies of the proposed paper or PhD thesis in English. If a PhD thesis is not available in English, a publication based on this thesis in a reviewed journal (in English) is requested. Instead of printed versions, access to electronic versions of the paper or thesis shall be sufficient.

Who can recommend a candidate for the Young Scientist Award?

The following bodies may recommend candidates: (i) any EMS Member or Associate Member and (ii) the EMS Awards Committee. Each of the aforementioned bodies may nominate up to two candidates.

Where should the proposals be submitted?

How will the Award be presented?

The Award will be presented during the Opening Session of the seventh EMS Annual Meeting and eighth European Conference on Applications of Meteorology 2007. The recipient will receive a certificate, a cheque and a letter of congratulations.
