Introduction

Kipp & Zonen, manufacturer of meteorological instruments, is proud to announce its Award for Boundary Layer Research. It shall be awarded to an aspiring young scientist presenting an outstanding research paper on Boundary Layer Meteorology at a conference. The Award was launched in the year 2005, when Kipp & Zonen celebrated its 175th anniversary and first awarded at the 5th Annual Meeting of the European Meteorological Society, jointly held with the European Conference on Applications of Meteorology (ECAM) in Utrecht, 12-16 September 2005. In 2008, the Award will be given at the 8th Annual Meeting of the EMS which will be held together with the European Conference on Applied Climatology in Amsterdam,

Scope - Eligibility

The award consists of a prize money of 1000 Euro and expenses for travel and accommodation. Proposing candidates can be done in three ways:

- candidates may propose themselves;
- they can be proposed by the scientific committee of the conference;
- they can be proposed by conveners of sessions at the conference.

Requirements for the 2008 Award

The following set of requirements applies:

- Candidates can come from any country.
- Candidates shall be under 35 years of age on the first of January 2008.
- The Award shall be given to a scientist presenting an excellent paper at the 8th EMS Annual Meeting/ECAC conference.
- The encouraged field of research is Boundary Layer Meteorology and specifically related to solar radiation (UV, Visible and FIR) and direct effects.
- The proposal shall be submitted to the EMS Secretariat at ems-sec@met.fu-berlin.de.
- Proposals shall be arriving no later than **1 August 2008**.
- The selection shall be based on the following documentation
 - a short curriculum vitae
 - a document to determine the age of the candidate
 - a supporting statement (e.g. by a conference convener)
 - a copy of the letter of acceptance for an oral or a poster presentation
 - the abstract submitted to the conference.

Presentation of the Award

The Award, including the cheque and the certificate will be presented during the 8th EMS Annual Meeting.
