Brocken summit: The highest mountain in North Germany (1141 m asl), home of the longest time series of fog collection in Europe, main observation point of the German Weather Service (DWD).

Departure: Saturday, 31 July 2010, 8:00 hrs

Bus-time: 5 hours one way, plus historic train to the Brocken summit (45 min)

Special ware: sturdy shoes, be prepared for harsh and windy weather conditions
