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Space weather effects at Titan, Venus and Mars

Titan, Venus and Mars are all unmagnetized objects in different plasma environments: Titan in the rotating, hot magnetosphere of Saturn, and Mars and Venus in the solar wind. In this talk we contrast the plasma interactions at these objects and present some results from Cassini, Venus Express and Mars Express to illustrate the similarities and differences.
