Alan G. Green wins EGU Stephan Mueller Medal 2005

The British scientist Alan G. Green has won the prestigious EGU Stephan Mueller Medal in recognition of his fundamental contributions to the exploration of the structure of the crust and lithosphere at all scales and of his efforts in promoting interdisciplinary geoscience programs.

This medal has been established by the EGU Section on Solid Earth Geophysics in recognition of the scientific achievements of Stephan Mueller. This medal is reserved for scientists in recognition of their outstanding contributions to Tectonics and Lithospheric Geophysics.

Professor Green will accept his medal and give his Medal lecture during the EGU General Assembly, to be held in Vienna, Austria from 24 – 29 april 2005. The lecture starts at 18.00 h, 25th of April.

Alan G. Green is a Professor of Applied and Environmental Geophysics at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Zurich.
