It shall be awarded to an aspiring young scientist presenting an outstanding research paper on Boundary Layer Meteorology at a conference. The Award was launched in the year 2005, when Kipp & Zonen celebrated its 175th anniversary. In 2009, the Award will be given at the 9th EMS Annual Meeting & 9th European Conference on Applications of Meteorology (ECAM) in Toulouse.

The Award

The award consists of a prize money of 1000 Euro, expenses for travel and accommodation and an Awards certificate.

Requirements for the 2009 Award

The following set of requirements applies:

- 1. Candidates can come from any country.
- 2. Candidates shall be under 35 years of age on the first of January 2009.
- 3. The Award shall be given to a scientist presenting an excellent paper at the 9th EMS Annual Meeting/ECAM conference.
- 4. The encouraged field of research is Boundary Layer Meteorology and specifically related to solar radiation (UV, Visible and FIR) and direct effects.
