10 Young Scientist Travel Awards (YSTA)

to support the participation of young scientists at the EMS Annual Meeting & European Conference on Applied Climatology in Zürich, Switzerland.

These awards include a free conference registration and additional financial support for travel expenditures of 300€.

Eligibility

Young scientists under 35 years of age on the first of January 2010, working and/or studying in a European country are eligible for an award. All countries with an EMS Member Society or included in the WMO RAVI region are considered as European. Application procedure:

1) Submit your abstract at meetings.copernicus.org/ems2010, and tick the box „EMS Young Scientist Travel Award“ in the abstract submission tool. **Please note that abstract submission with YSTA application will close on Friday, 09 April 2009.**

2) Send the documents listed under (i) -(iii) to awardapplication@emetsoc.org no later than **09 April 2010**.

Documents (i) and (ii) must be provided in pdf-format.

- (i) a short curriculum vitae,
- (ii) a supporting statement (e.g. by an EMS Member Society or an EMS Associate Member),
- (iii) a document to determine the age of the candidate.

A certificate will be presented to selected awardees during the Opening Session on Monday, 13 September 2010. The awardees are expected to provide a report of the conference for publication at the emetsoc.org.
