The International Journal of Biometeorology (IJB) is the official journal of the International Society of Biometeorology. It has more than 300 members from over 40 countries. The IJB which is published 6 times a year welcomes original research papers and review articles on studies concerning the interactions between living organisms and factors of the natural and artificial environment. The IJB editorial board consists of 7 members covering 6 research fields such as Animals, Agriculture and Forest Meteorology, Built Environments, Epidemiology, Humans, and Phenology.

During the last year, the IJB received 166 manuscripts submissions from 35 countries, and 58% of these were accepted for publication. Beginning from March 2006, the IJB adopted a new policy of online manuscript submission (<https://www.editorialmanager.com/ijbm/>). Once you online submitted your manuscript, you can track the progress of your manuscript all the way through the system. In this system, a wide range of submission file formats are accepted that includes Word, RTF, TIFF, GIF, JPEG, EPS, Excel and PowerPoint. Further, once your manuscript is accepted for publication, it will be published immediately and electronically as well as in hard copy at a later time.
